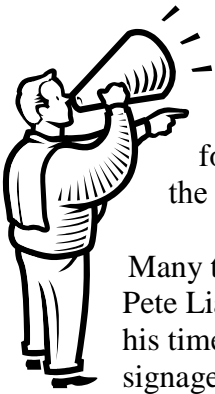


Manager's Corner

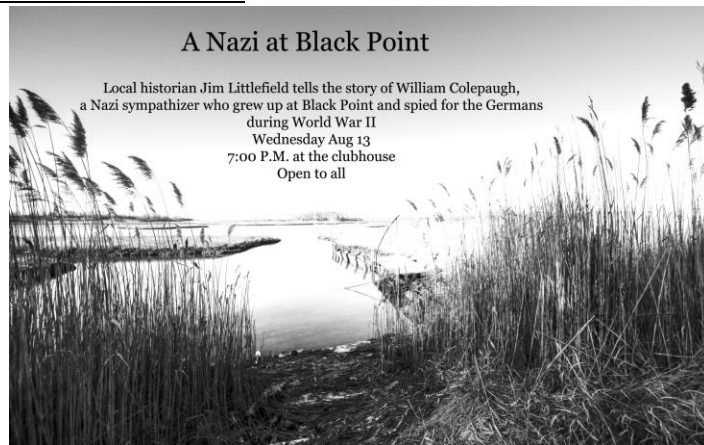
